- The original Hebrew meaning of "praise the beauty of holiness" would be "**Boast** in the adornment of set-apartness" (See Isaiah 61:10)

Why is praise set out in front of the army? Psalm 7:11-13; 22:3; 92:13; 100:4

2 Chronicles 20:22-24 - When we praise God, He is enthroned in our praises and shoots arrows at our enemies!!!! Exactly what happens in Jehoshaphat's story.
